Today, the children learned all about Pantosaurus. First we listened to the Talk PANTS song https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=LnroTxz7USI. Following this, we read the story "Pantosaurus and the Power of PANTS", which reinforced the idea that our private parts are private, and that it's always okay to say no and to speak to a trusted adult. The children were engaged throughout the session and are beginning to understand that their bodies belong to them.

Here are the PANTS rules:

P: Privates are private

A: Always remember your body belongs to you

N: No means no

T: Talk about secrets that upset you

S: Speak up, someone can help

Smile Squad are coming to Parr



The Smile Squad will be visiting Parr Children's Centre on **Monday 1 December**, **10am-1pm** to promote positive oral health for children and families.

This is a fantastic opportunity to highlight the work of our Family Hubs and offer support to families—especially those who may be struggling to find an NHS dentist. Please share this opportunity with families you may work with or take part with your own family.

This initiative is part of a broader mission to improve early childhood oral health in the community. Tooth decay is the most common reason for hospital admission in children aged six to ten, with those in less affluent communities more likely to suffer from poor oral health.

In St Helens Borough, more than 31 per cent of five-year-olds had visible signs of tooth decay in 2021-22, higher than the national average of 23.7 per cent.

Poor oral health in children results in an average of three missed school days each year and may also limit their academic performance and future potential.
