Description			
<p>Built by John Middlehurst and overseen by Father Ignatius Spencer. The church currently on the site is not the original building following two occasions of subsidence which caused damage to the church. The current church was opened in 1973 and blessed by George Beck, Archbishop of Liverpool. It was built using the Wanner system of preformed struts and consists of an octagonal structure that a small octagonal chapel has been added onto. Both are faced in brown brick laid in stretcher bond and with tile coverings to the conical roof. The church is the burial place and shrine to three notable figures from the Catholic 'Second Spring': the Blessed Dominic Barberi, and the Venerable Ignatius Spencer and the Venerable Elizabeth Prout.</p>
