**ST HELENS TOWN CENTRE REGENERATION:  
NOTIFICATION OF TRAFFIC REGULATION ORDER (TRO) ENGAGEMENT.**

As part of the transformational St Helens town centre regeneration project, St Helens Borough Council are carrying out an initial engagement on the TROs required to facilitate the proposed setup as part of development works.

**WHAT IS A TRO?**

A Traffic Regulation Order (TRO) is a legal document/process that allows authorities to control traffic flow and waiting areas through restrictions such as speed limits, parking restrictions, one-way streets, and banned turns. These orders are used to improve road safety, manage congestion, and provide access for specific purposes, like loading bays and accessible parking.
