

## **LICENSING ACT 2003**

Representation made in respect of a new grant or variation of a Premises
Licence or Club Premises Certificate

## PLEASE READ THE FOLLOWING INSTRUCTIONS BEFORE COMPLETING THE ATTACHED FORMS.

If you wish to make representations about an application under consideration you may use this form. The law does not require a representation to be in a standard format, however the Licensing Authority is obliged to decide whether your representation is valid within the requirements of the Act and Regulations.

Consequently you are invited to submit your representations in this format. This will help us to clarify the grounds upon which you are making representations and the form will assist you in ensuring that you have entered your representations properly and fully.

The ground(s) for representation must be based on one or more of the licensing objectives, namely:-

The prevention of crime and disorder; Public safety; The prevention of public nuisance; and The protection of children from harm;

Please list any additional information or details to support your representation and attach any documentary or other information that you may wish to use. If you have not disclosed this information, you will not be able to introduce it at any hearing (should a hearing be required) unless all the other parties give their consent.

## **How the Council deals with representations**

St Helens Council as Licensing Authority must examine all representations submitted to establish whether they are valid and relevant to the application.

Only representations that relate to the likely effect of the granting/variation of the licence/certificate on one or more of the licensing objectives can be considered.

Each licensing objective is of equal importance.

Some examples of issues, which may be considered outside the scope for consideration are:-

- Representations which are frivolous or vexatious:
- Commercial considerations or demand;

- Matters which duplicate or relate to other legislation, e.g. fire precautions, restrictions on a planning permission;
- Matters which are outside the control of the applicant, e.g. on street parking, traffic and general anti social behaviour;
- Speculation about the effects of the licence being granted; and

PREMISES TO WHICH THIS REPRESENTATION RELATES

• The legislation/guidance states that shops, stores and supermarkets should normally be free to provide sales of alcohol for consumption off the premises at any times when the retail outlet is open for shopping unless there are good reasons, based on the licensing objectives for restricting those hours.
