



# **Review of Polling Districts, Polling Places and Polling Stations 2021**

## **(Acting) Returning Officer's Representations**

### **Definitions**

#### **What is a Polling District?**

A polling district is a geographical area created by the sub-division of an electoral area, i.e. a ward or parliamentary constituency, into smaller parts. A polling district will not breach ward boundaries.

#### **What is a Polling Place?**

A polling place is a building (e.g. a school or community centre) or area in which a polling station is located.

#### **What is a Polling Station?**

A polling station is the physical location (i.e. the room) where the process of voting takes place.
