

Notice of Conclusion of Review of Polling Districts, Polling Places and Polling Stations

Electoral Registration and Administration Act 2013 – Section 17, Electoral Administration Act 2006 – Section 16, Representation of the People Act 1983 – Sections 18A-18E and Schedule 1

Following ward boundary changes St Helens Borough Council has concluded a review of Polling Districts and Polling Places.

The Council has taken into account public comments, observations and representations in reaching its decisions, and has now published a final list of Polling Districts, Polling Places and Polling Stations that will come into force when register is republished on 1 February 2022.

Following the conclusion of the local authority's review certain persons have a right to make representations to the Electoral Commission.

The Electoral Commission will only consider representations that the review process has not been conducted correctly and has failed to meet the reasonable requirements of the electors in the constituency or has failed to take sufficient account of accessibility to disabled persons of the polling stations within a polling place.
