- 3. If any election is contested the poll will take place on Thursday, 5th May 2022.
- 4. Applications to register to vote must reach the Electoral Registration Officer by 12 midnight on **Thursday, 14 April 2022.** Applications can be made online: https://www.gov.uk/register-to-vote.
- 5. Applications, amendments or cancellations of postal votes and amendments or cancellations of proxy votes must reach the Electoral Registration Officer at St Helens Town Hall, Victoria Square, St Helens, Merseyside WA10 1HP by **5 pm on Tuesday, 19th April 2022**.
- 6. Applications to vote by proxy at this election must reach the Electoral Registration Officer at St Helens Town Hall, Victoria Square, St Helens, Merseyside WA10 1HP by 5 pm on Tuesday, 26th April 2022.
- 7. Applications to vote by emergency proxy at this election must reach the Electoral Registration Officer at St Helens Town Hall, Victoria Square, St Helens, Merseyside WA10 1HP by 5 pm on Thursday, 5th May 2022.
