Both our nursery provision's offer 15 hours per week within a stimulating and nurturing environment that support children's individual needs.

Central Link Monday - Friday 9.15am - 12.30pm

Parr Monday - Friday 1.00pm - 4.15pm



What referrers can expect from the provision:

- The child will be cared for by our dedicated and experienced team with a keyworker allocated to the child who will provide you with regular updates on the child's learning and development
- Daily case notes will be added onto the child's record on ICS or EHAT and will include observations focusing on the voice of the child
- The nursery manager will contact referrers if there are any concerns or safeguarding issues
- Regular updates on the child's development and parental engagement
- Attendance at meetings to provide updates on the progress of the child and family

What we expect from referrers:

- Invitations to meetings relating to the child and family
- Regular correspondence with the Nursery Manager

- Update nursery with any significant events relating to the child and family
- To ensure that the parent/carer attends the Parent and Child programme which will enhance their understanding of different aspects of child development and how children learn through play
- To provide regular feedback on the impact of the nursery and the Parent and Child programme.
