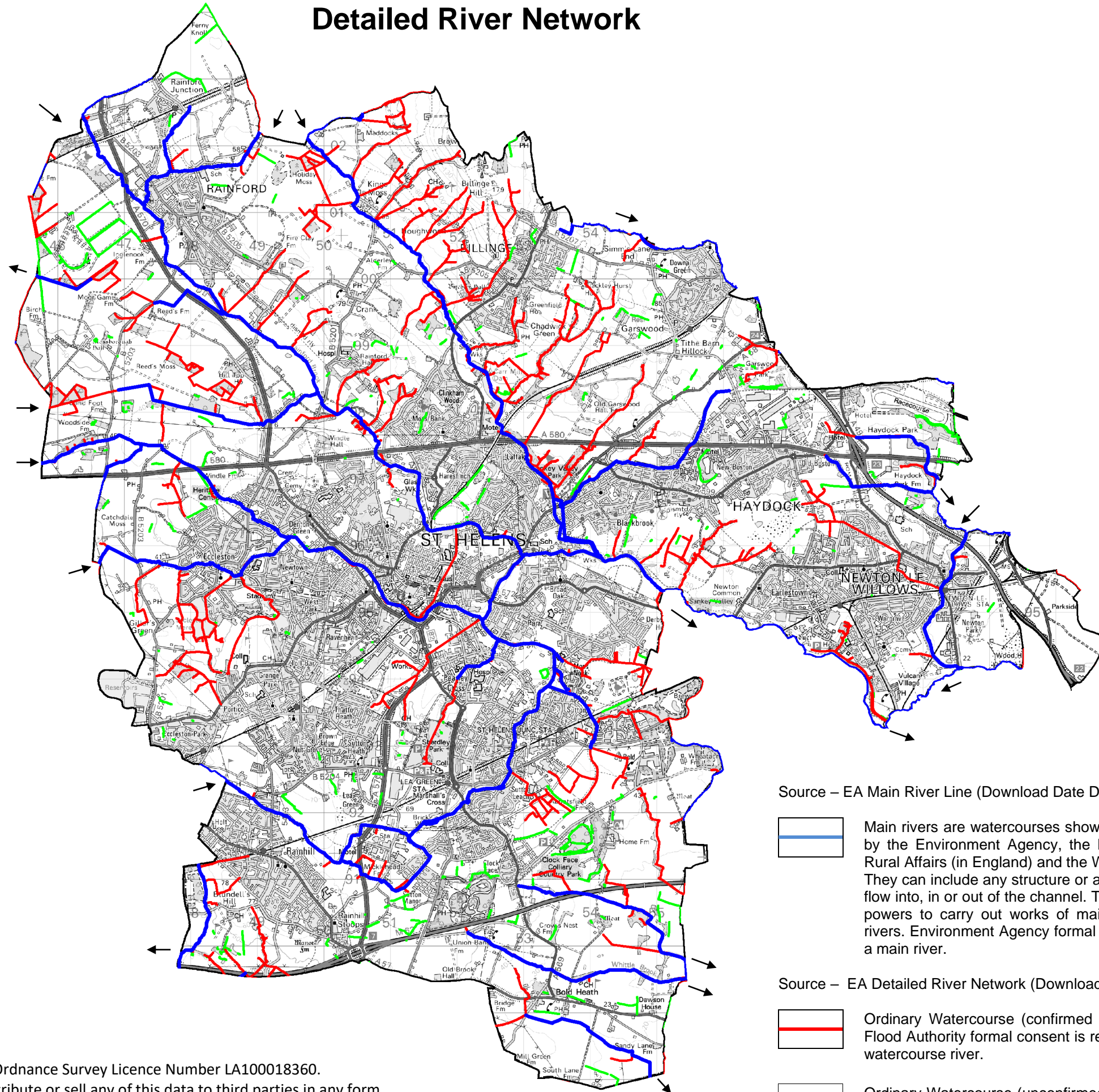


Appendix A Figure 1 Detailed River Network

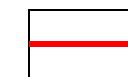

Main rivers are watercourses shown on the statutory main river maps held by the Environment Agency, the Department of Environment, Food and Rural Affairs (in England) and the Welsh Assembly Government (in Wales). They can include any structure or appliance for controlling or regulating the flow into, in or out of the channel. The Environment Agency has permissive powers to carry out works of maintenance and improvements on these rivers. Environment Agency formal consent is required for works that affect a main river.
