## St Helens Southern Gateway Walking and Cycling Improvement Scheme update (Roadworks)

Dear Resident.

I am writing further to my recent correspondence regarding the above project.

Following the completion of the works on Marshalls Cross Road/Elton Head Road for the new traffic signals (Friday 16 June), the next stage of our construction will be commencing for the resurfacing of the carriageway Bull and Dog roundabout. This is a continuation of the work we have been doing to improve the walking and cycling infrastructure across the Borough.

To undertake this aspect of work it is necessary to close several roads to traffic, to ensure safe working areas for our contractor and the general public/cyclists/motorists.

The roads will be closed over several weeks through the summer holidays and will be closed 24hrs a day during the below dates. Attached is a plan showing each closure on the back of the letter.

- 1. Phase 1 Mill Lane (Both directions) Clock Face Road and Marshalls Cross Road southbound only 20 July to 6 August 2023
- Phase 2 Chester Lane (both directions) Clock Face Road and Marshalls Cross Road northbound only 7 August to 20
  August 2023
- 3. Phase 3 Elton Head Road (both directions) from Sutton Sports Centre to Marshalls Cross Road 21 August to 27 August 2023
- 4. Phase 4 Marshalls Cross Road Southbound only from Eaves Lane to Elton Head Road 29 August to 1 September 2023

It is anticipated that the works will impact on the road network and vehicle users journey times may increase. We apologise for any disruption caused during these works. Our contractor will endeavor to seek efficiencies in the programme to keep the road network moving.

During this period, traffic will be diverted on the local road network and will be clearly signed. To view all the diversion routes please visit the website one.network
