NOTIFICATION OF ROADWORKS – PARKSIDE LINK ROAD (PLR): JUNCTION MITIGATION

St Helens Borough Council are contacting you to provide an update in relation to the Parkside Junction Mitigation Schemes.

Works at the A49 Mill Lane/A572 Southworth Road is substantially complete, and St Helens Borough Council would like to thank everyone for their co-operation during the construction activities at this junction.

A572 Southworth Road/A573 Parkside Road

January 2024 will see the commencement of the other two schemes, with the first being at A572 Southworth Road/A573 Parkside Road which is due to commence on 2nd January 2023 for approximately 5 months. From 2nd January 2024 the A573 Parkside Link Road will be closed from the junction of A572 Southworth Road for approximately two weeks and the diversion route will be signed.

M6 Junction 22

The final scheme as part of the mitigation schemes will be at the M6 Junction 22 and will commence mid-January 2024. The main Traffic Management setup within the M6 Junction 22 scheme will be a reduction to single lane running around the circulatory of the motorway junction, however, to construct the scheme safely there will be occasions where the carriageway, and where appropriate, motorway access/egress points will also be closed to vehicular traffic. Advanced warning of these closures will be issued prior to the event.

As with all highway improvement schemes, we do anticipate an element of disruption to the network. Please be assured that St Helens Borough Council, working closely with their contractors, will try to mitigate any delay where possible. We must however ensure that these works are delivered safely. We recommend allowing additional time for your journey during the construction works.
