Do you have a conversation with the 0-19 Team any time soon?

Do any children in your nursery meet the following:

A&E attendances with wheezy episodes in the last year

Any admissions in the last 3 months with wheezy episode.
Using salbutamol frequently (picking up more than 2 in the last 3 months)
Highest fuel poverty quintile
Aged 18 months -5 years

If yes, please mention them to the health colleagues (0-19 Team), these children might get tailored support from the Respiratory HUB. The respiratory clinic has been recently established to support families with children under the age of 5s who meet the above requirements. The health colleagues can refer and tailored support for the family's housing conditions (air quality), the child's health and a review of the condition.
