
Marmot Beacon Indicators - St. Helens 2024: A comparison to England



St. Helens Facts

185,982 people live in St. Helens. Around **43%** of the population live in the top 20% most deprived areas in England.

Women can expect to live to **80.5 years** and men to **76.8 years.** On average, men will spend **25.7%** of their lives in poor health and women will spend **28.7%** of their lives in poor health.
