

What happens now?

Inform your training provider

If you are eligible and wish to receive the bursary, you will need to inform your training provider. This is because the bursary is claimed by your training provider, who then passes the money on to you.

Provide evidence

Your training provider will ask you to provide written confirmation from the local authority where you were in care to verify that you are eligible. This can be a signed letter or email from your Personal Advisor or somebody else in the Leaving Care team. You will also need to confirm your age to your training provider and sign a declaration to state you wish to receive the bursary.

Make the claim

Once they have received this information, your provider should make the claim and will pass the money on to you in three instalments at approximately 3 months, 6 months and 12 months from the date you started your apprenticeship.
